

Both current Ex'pression College students and applicants are eligible to apply for an Ex'pression Scholarship. These scholarships are intended primarily for students and applicants who have excelled academically and demonstrate artistic potential. Significant financial need may also be considered when determining scholarship awards.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by our Scholarship Committee for the upcoming academic year. For more information and the next deadline, check online at expression.edu/scholarships

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to receive an Ex'pression Scholarship, scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be currently enrolled as a student at Ex'pression College or be a current applicant with an anticipated start date at Ex'pression College within the next six months.
- Achieved at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA on most recent transcript (high school, previous college with at least 24 credits, or Ex'pression College).
- Submit a completed application. Incomplete applications will be deemed ineligible and will not be considered during the selection process. A completed application must include:
 - Copy of your most recent transcript
 - Letter of Recommendation
 - Personal Essay
 - Signed Application Form
 - Artistic Work Samples

Required Documents

All documents and sample work must be clearly labeled with your name.

Transcript

Please include a copy of your most recent academic transcript (high school, previous college with at least 24 credits, or Ex'pression College). You must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA on this transcript.

Personal Essay

In 500 words or less, please describe your career goals in as much detail as possible, including how you expect to attain these goals, and why attending Ex'pression College is important to you.

Letter of Recommendation

Please include a letter of recommendation from a high school/college teacher or employer who can attest to your commitment to success and your creative potential.

Artistic Work Samples

Please submit no more than two pieces of artistic work (drawing portfolio, musical score, CD demo, graphic image, etc.) that demonstrate your artistic creativity. Along with each piece of work, please attach a short statement explaining why you chose the piece and what you were trying to communicate with it. Acceptable formats for submission include:

- JPG or PDF files for artwork
- Prints or illustrations no larger than 8.5" x 11" in size
- MP3 or MP4 files for audio tracks
- QuickTime files for video

If you are submitting your completed application via email or online, your total file size cannot exceed 50MB. For larger video submissions, we recommend that you place your video on an external website such as vimeo or youtube and include this link along with your statement about the video with your application materials.
